RULES OF LENT

DAYS OF FAST GOOD FRIDAY: Limit one full meal on this day for all who are 18 years old, but not yet 60 years old. Two other meatless meals may be taken, but together should not equal a full meal.


DAYS OF ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT: All Fridays of Lent: An obligation for those who are 14 years old and up.

WEEKDAYS OF LENT: There is no longer an obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial and charity are recommended.

EASTER DUTY: The obligation to receive Communion at least once a year, during the Easter Season. This obligation may be fulfilled between the first Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday, May 22, 2016.

PARISH COUNCIL ELECTION will take place on the weekend of April 23/24, 2016. There will be three seats to be filled. We ask that you prayerfully consider running for a seat on the Council.
