### LETTER FROM THE OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

Guidelines for fulfillment of Christmas Mass Obligations:

- Sunday Obligation, December 23 & 24: The faithful may attend a Vigil Mass on Saturday, December 23 or any Mass on Sunday, December 24th (including any Christmas Vigil that concludes before midnight) in order to fulfill the Sunday obligation. Should one choose to fulfill his or her Sunday obligation by participating in a Christmas Vigil Mass, one should also attend Mass on Monday, December 25th in order to fulfill the Christmas obligation.
- Christmas Obligation, December 24-25: The faithful may attend a Vigil Mass or Midnight Mass on December 24th or any Mass on Monday, December 25th in order to fulfill the Christmas obligation (unless as noted above, the Christmas Vitgil fulfills the Sunday obligation).

The upcoming Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is <u>NOT</u> a Holy Day of Obligatoin since it falls on a Monday. While the faithful are encouraged to attend that celebration, it is not required.

#### LETTER FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners.

The Peace of Christ be with you!!!

The third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday" because the Mass for today (in its original Latin text), begins with the opening antiphon, "Gaudette in Domino sempter"- "Rejoice in the Lord always". To remind ourselves that we are preparing for the very joyful occasion of the birth of Jesus, we light the rose candle, and the priest may wear rose vestments. The common theme of the day's Scripture readings is one of joy and encouragement. The readings urge us to make the preparations required of us as we await the rebirth of Jesus in our hearts and lives. Holy Scripture reminds us that the coming of Jesus, past, present and future, is the reason for our rejoicing.

In the First Reading, the Prophet Isaiah encourages the Jewish exiles returning from Babylon to rejoice because their God, Yahweh, is their strong Guide, Provider and Protector.

Today's Responsorial Psalm (Luke 1:46 ff) Mary rejoices in the great blessing given to her by exclaiming "My soul glorifies the Lord, my spirit finds joy in God my Savior."

In the Second Reading, St. Paul advises the Thessalonian Christians to "rejoice always" by leading blameless, holy and thankful lives guided by the Holy Spirit, because Christ's second coming is near, and He is faithful in His promise to reward them.

Today's Gospel tells us that John the Baptizer who tells the Sanhedren members challenging Him that He is unworthy even to become the slave of Jesus the Messiah. We also rejoice at the humility of John the Baptizer who tells the Sanhedrin members challenging him that he is unworthy even to become the slave of himself completely in preparing people for the long-awaited Messiah. We have an additional reason to rejoice because, like John the Baptizer, we, too, are chosen to bear witness to Christ Jesus, the Light of the world.

We need to bear witness to Christ the Light. Our mission as brothers and sisters of Christ and members of His Church is to reflect Christ's Light to others, just as the moon reflects the light of the sun. It is especially important during the Advent season that we reflect Christ's sharing love and His unconditional forgiveness. There are too many people who live in darkness and poverty, and who lack real freedom because of their evil addictions and bad choices. There are others who are deafened and blinded by the cheap attractions of the world. Many others who are deafened and blinded marginalized. Let us bring the true Light of Christ to illume the lives of all these brothers and sisters during this Advent season through our sharing love, overflowing mercy, unconditional forgiveness and humble service. We will be able to accomplish this witnessing mission of radiating Christ's Light only by repenting of our sins asking God's pardon every day and renewing our lives by our daily prayers, by frequenting the Sacrament of Reconciliation, by attending and taking part in the Eucharistic celebration, by reading the Bible daily in meditative, prayerful fashion and by performing the corporal and spiritual works of mercy where we see these are needed. Have a blessed Sunday!
